## 1) Deliverable description

The database is presented in one single file with 4 excel sheets, dividing the identified stakeholders as follows:

- Sheet 1, STK P5T: list of local and international partners based on the work carried out by all the partners coordinated by Legambiente, divided into 4 categories:
  - 2) Voluntary associations, foundations, networks
  - 3) Farms, tourism-hospitality activities, sectorial associations
  - 4) Universities, scientific networks, museums, study centers, schools
  - 5) Local administrations and public bodies.

  - Other Associations / Foundations


For each stakeholder the country, contact person, website, email, telephone number, address have been identified.
